South Neuchâtel Citizens' assembly

Dear Madam / Sir,

The creation of citizens' assemblies is included in the merger agreement between the towns of Corcelles-Cormondrèche, Neuchâtel, Peseux and Valangin, and will be implemented in the first half of 2023. The aim of the new town of Neuchâtel is to set up a tool for local democracy that meets as closely as possible the expectations of its inhabitants. Any person residing in this new town will be able to take part in the debates of the citizens' assembly of his or her area of residence.

With this in mind, we invite you to the constitutive session of the South Neuchâtel citizens' assembly, **on Monday 15 May, at 7:30 pm, at the Temple du Bas, rue du Temple-Neuf 5, in Neuchâtel.**

On that occasion, the primary goals and principles governing the citizens' assemblies will be presented to you, as well as the means and the democratic tools available to the participants. We will then proceed to the appointment of the committee by drawing lots (with right of refusal) amongst the persons present.
